

Secondary Campuses Remote Instruction Notice – March 18, 2020

On Monday, March 23rd, Lytle Junior High & High School began remote instruction and learning through our learning management system, Blackboard. Students have been using Blackboard in most of their classes and are familiar with this method of learning.

Teachers will begin providing instructional content and assignments on a weekly basis. The following is the schedule for release of content:

Monday: Math

Tuesday: Electives

Wednesday: ELA/SST

Thursday: Science

Friday: Electives

All assignments are due 7 days after the release date. Every teacher will have a syllabus posted in their Blackboard class with office hours and contact information. There will also be a discussion forum in each class where parents and students can send questions to their respective teacher.

Over the last few days, our campus staff has been working to gather information regarding students' Internet access at home. If you have not provided the campuses with this information, please contact your campus advising that your child does not have access to remote learning. If remote learning is not possible, we will work with individual students to provide an alternate method of learning.
